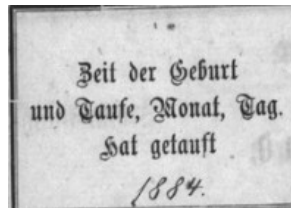

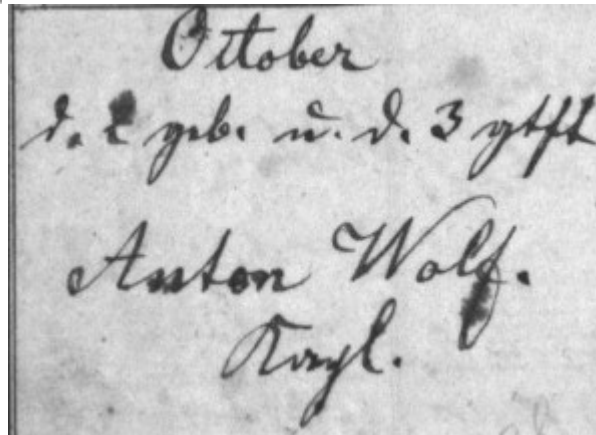

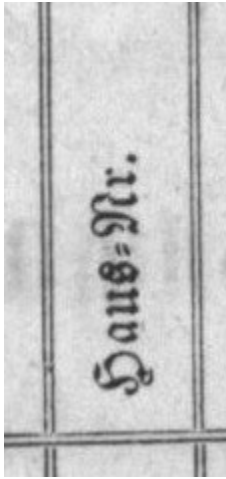

The current Czech name is probably Detrichov
He would have been baptised in the parish church for Dittershof



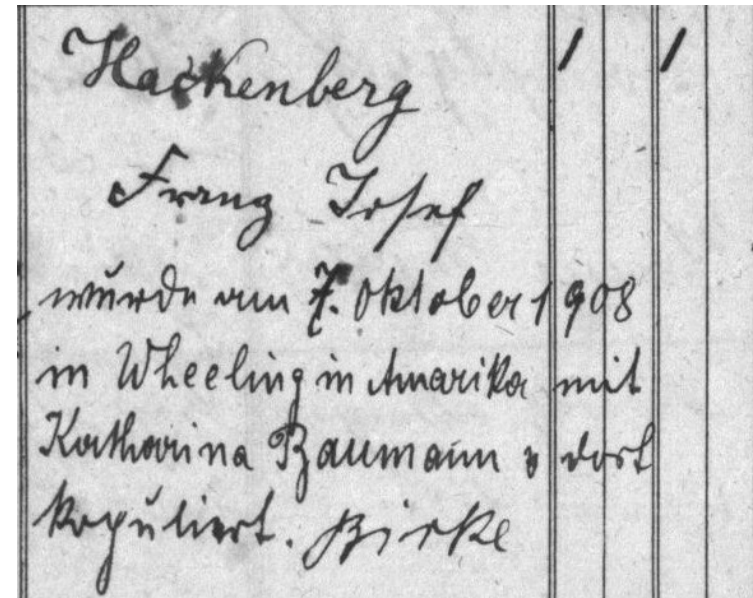

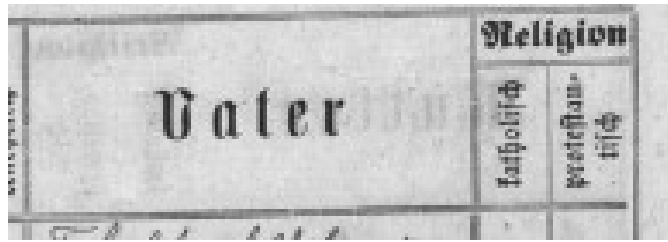

Franz Josef was a boy, he was legitimate (parents were married)

Hackenber Josef son of deceased Josef Hackenberg, tradesman
 in Dittershof and Klara born Siegel from Nieder Thomasdorf.

Note: The father and the grandfather of Franz Josef were both
 named Josef. Both were from Dittershof (three generations in
 the same place). Both were *Wirtschaftlers* which probably
 means that they sold some kind of goods to the public, possibly
 farm produce.

Franz Josef's father brought the whole family to Wheeling, WV
 in 1890.

At the very bottom is Josef's signature to the baptism record.


